

Little 'Uns



Jobaria

When crocheted with yarns and hook specified, Jobaria measures 16 inches L with a standing height of 10 ½ inches.

This pattern is crocheted in the amigurumi style of continuous rounds beginning from a double yarn loop. Marking the last stitch of increase and decrease rounds with a small length of yarn or a safety pin will help you to keep track.

Materials

F/5 3.75mm crochet hook

1 (6 ounce skein) Caron Simply Soft 'Pagoda' (or other soft worsted weight) yarn

1 yard pink yarn for mouth

15mm animal safety eyes (or 2 (5/8") solid-front buttons)

Sewing thread, needle and pins

Polyester fiberfill for stuffing (4 - 5 ounces)

Yarn needle



Pattern abbreviations

Rnd - Round

ch - chain

sc - single crochet stitch

hdc - half double crochet stitch

sc inc - single crochet increase (2 single crochet stitches into 1 stitch)

sc dec - single crochet decrease (insert hook into 1st sc, draw up loop, insert hook into next sc, draw up loop, yarn over and pull hook through all loops)

Sl st: Slip stitch

- Repeat directions between * as indicated

Legs (make 4)

Use Pagoda yarn and F hook

Crochet 6 sc into double loop, pull loop end to close

Rnd 1: *2 sc into each sc* 6 times (12 sc)

Rnd 2: *3 sc, 2 sc inc* 3 times (15 sc)

Rnd 3: In FLO except for hdc sts – 1 sc into each of 4 sc, *3 hdc in next sc, 1 sc into each next 2 sc* 2 times, 3 hdc into next sc, 1 sc into each next 4 sc (21 sts)

Rnd 4: 1 sc into each next 4 sc, *skip hdcs, 1 sc into each next 2 sc* 2 times, skip hdcs, 1 sc into each next 4 sc (12 sc)

Rnds 5-17: 12 sc (13 rounds)

Sl st into next sc, tie off, leaving long enough yarn length to sew leg to body later.

Mouth

Use pink yarn and F hook

Leaving a 6 inch length of yarn on end of ch, ch 5, tie off, leaving an 8 inch yarn length.

With yarn needle, thread shorter yarn length and pull yarn to inside on one side of snout to anchor, arrange mouth in preferred expression, thread yarn needle with longer end, pull to inside and back out through 1st ch on that end, sew in and out over chains to end, pull yarn to inside and tie together with shorter end, trim ends.



Head

Use Pagoda yarn and F hook

Crochet 6 sc into double loop, pull loop end to close

Rnd 1: *2 sc into each sc* 6 times (12 sc)

Rnd 2: 3 sc, 2 sc inc; 4 sc, 2 sc inc; 3 sc (14 sc)

Rnd 3: 4 sc, 2 sc inc; 4 sc, 2 sc inc; 4 sc (16 sc)

Rnd 4: 4 sc, 2 sc inc; 6 sc, 2 sc inc; 4 sc (18 sc)

Rnd 5: 4 sc, 2 sc inc; 8 sc, 2 sc inc; 4 sc (20 sc)

Rnd 6: 5 sc, 2 sc inc; 8 sc, 2 sc inc; 5 sc (22 sc)

Rnd 7: 5 sc, 2 sc inc; 10 sc, 2 sc inc; 5 sc (24 sc)

Rnd 8: 6 sc, 2 sc inc; *1 sc, 2 sc inc* 5 times; 7 sc (30 sc)

Rnd 9: 7 sc, 2 sc inc; *4 sc, 2 sc inc* 3 times; 7 sc (34 sc)

Rnd 10: *6 sc, 2 sc inc* 4 times; 6 sc (38 sc)

Rnds 11-16: 38 sc (6 rounds) Attach eyes and sew on mouth

Rnd 17: 10 sc, 2 sc dec; *7 sc, 2 sc dec* 2 times; 8 sc (35 sc)

Rnd 18: *5 sc, 2 sc dec* 5 times (30 sc)

Rnd 19: *3 sc, 2 sc dec* 6 times (24 sc)

Rnd 20: *2 sc, 2 sc dec* 6 times (18 sc)

Stuff head firmly, adding more stuffing as necessary as you close

Rnd 21: *1 sc, 2 sc dec* 6 times (12 sc)

Rnds 22-23: *2 sc dec* 8 times to close

Tie off, thread end with yarn needle, draw it through closing round and back out a couple rounds away, pull taut and snip close to head to keep end inside.

Tail/Body

Use Pagoda yarn and F hook

Crochet 4 sc into double loop, pull loop end to close

Rnd 1: 3 sc, 2 sc inc (5 sc)

Rnd 2: 4 sc, 2 sc inc (6 sc)

Rnd 3: 5 sc, 2 sc inc (7 sc)

Rnd 4: 6 sc, 2 sc inc (8 sc)

Rnd 5: 7 sc, 2 sc inc (9 sc)

Rnds 6-9: 9 sc (4 rounds)

Rnd 10: 8 sc, 2 sc inc (10 sc)

Rnd 11: 10 sc

Rnd 12: 9 sc, 2 sc inc (11 sc)

Rnd 13-14: 11 sc (2 rounds)

Rnd 15: 10 sc, 2 sc inc (12 sc)

Rnd 16: *5 sc, 2 sc inc* 2 times (14 sc)



Rnd 17: 14 sc
 Rnd 18: *6 sc, 2 sc inc* 2 times (16 sc)
 Rnd 19: 16 sc
 Rnd 20: *7 sc, 2 sc inc* 2 times (18 sc)
 Rnd 21: 18 sc
 Rnd 22: *8 sc, 2 sc inc* 2 times (20 sc)
 Rnd 23: 20 sc
 Rnd 24: *9 sc, 2 sc inc* 2 times (22 sc)
 Rnd 25: 22 sc
 Rnd 26: *10 sc, 2 sc inc* 2 times (24 sc)
 Rnd 27: *7 sc, 2 sc inc* 3 times (27 sc)
 Rnd 28-29: 27 sc (2 rounds)
 Rnd 30: *8 sc, 2 sc inc* 3 times (30 sc)
 Rnds 31-32: 30 sc (2 rounds)
 Rnd 33: *9 sc, 2 sc inc* 3 times (33 sc)
 Rnds 34-35: 33 sc (2 rounds)
 Rnd 36: *10 sc, 2 sc inc* 3 times (36 sc)
 Rnds 37-38: 36 sc (2 rounds)
 Rnd 39: 7 sc, 2 sc inc; *6 sc, 2 sc inc* 3 times; 7 sc (40 sc)
 Rnd 40: 40 sc
 Rnd 41: 10 sc, 2 sc inc; *8 sc, 2 sc inc* 2 times; 11 sc (43 sc)
 Rnd 42: 43 sc
 Rnd 43: 9 sc, 2 sc inc; *5 sc, 2 sc inc* 4 times; 9 sc (48 sc)
 Stuff and sew on back legs just behind last round worked on bottom of body (last sc worked will be at the top of body), taking care not to sew into last round worked, stuff tail section firmly
 Rnds 44-50: 48 sc (7 rounds)
 Rnd 51: 11 sc, 2 sc dec; *6 sc, 2 sc dec* 3 times; 11 sc (44 sc)
 Rnds 52-54: 44 sc (3 rounds)
 Rnd 55: 10 sc, 2 sc dec; *5 sc, 2 sc dec* 3 times; 11 sc (40 sc)
 Rnds 56-58: 40 sc (3 rounds)
 Rnd 59: 10 sc, 2 sc dec; *4 sc, 2 sc dec* 3 times; 7 sc, ch 3, skip last 3 sc (36 sts)
 Rnd 60: Ch 4, skip 1st 4 sc, 2 sc; *2 sc, 2 sc dec* 6 times; 6 sc (the chs at the end of round 59 and beginning of round 60 create the neck opening, work sc into them as you would normally on a ch row) (30 sc)
 Stuff and sew on front legs 1 round behind last round worked
 Rnd 61: 4 sc; *2 sc, 2 sc dec* 6 times; 2 sc (24 sc)
 Stuff body firmly, adding stuffing as you close
 Rnd 62: *1 sc, 2 sc dec* 8 times (16 sc)
 Rnds 63-64: *2 sc dec* 11 times to close Tie off, snip yarn, thread with yarn needle, push into body near last st and out a few rounds away, pull taut and snip to hide end inside.



Neck

Rnd 1: Sl st yarn into 1st sc (on upper right) of neck opening, work 16 sc around opening, (including one sc into each side) work last sc into sc with the sl st.

Rnds 2-23: 16 sc (22 rounds) Add stuffing to neck as you work rounds, keeping neck very firm

Rnd 24: 2 sc dec, 5 sc, *2 sc inc* 2 times, 7 sc (17 sc)

Rnd 25: 2 sc dec, 6 sc, *2 sc inc* 2 times, 7 sc (18 sc)

Rnd 26: 18 sc

Sl st into next sc, tie off, leaving long enough yarn length to sew head to neck.

Pin head to neck with the back of the head even with the back of the neck, sew on.

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
